

THE JOY OF ULTRARUNNING

A beautiful 2012 Wasatch Front 100 Mile Endurance Run started at 5:00 a.m., Friday morning, September 7th at the East Mountain Wilderness Park in Kaysville, Utah. A record number of 289 starters lined up in the dark, and 36 hours later, a record total of 213 runners had successfully finished the run at the Homestead Resort in Midway, Utah. The finishing percentage was 74 percent, a remarkably high number.

These 213 runners successfully finished 100 miles of daylight, nighttime, and stunning scenery found in the Wasatch Mountains of Utah. The weather this year was just about as good as one might expect; there were times that the runners had the heat of midday to deal with, but overall the temperatures didn't get too high. Some clouds helped, but there was no threat of storms.

At Millcreek (Upper Big Water, mile 61.68) it can certainly get cold, being in the bottom of a canyon with a nice stream alongside. But, once the runners leave Millcreek canyon and gain about 300 feet of elevation, the temperature warms right up.

The winner was Jeff Browning with a time of 19:33:30, about three minutes more than last year's winner. The fastest time ever was by Geoff Roes, who in 2009 finished with a time of 18:30:55. Second place was earned by George Grygar with a time of 20:51:15. Benjamin Lewis took third in 21:35:49.

Emily Judd won the women's division in 24:14:35. It turns out that Emily took second last year in 26:46:46. So this year, she came back to finish in about 2.5 hours faster. Her time was about an hour and 40 minutes faster than the 2011 first place woman's time. Impressive! Sarah Evans ran for second with a time of 24:42:20.

Emily and Sarah ran in close to each other all the way to Brighton. In fact, they both left Brighton at 10:01 p.m. They were almost shoulder to shoulder until Rock Springs when Emily put about five minutes on Sarah. Emily gradually increased her lead to arrive at the finish about 28 minutes ahead.

The women's third place finisher was Amie Blackham, who was in fourth through the aid stations until she reached Alexander Springs, where she took over, and kept, third place all the way to the Homestead Resort, crossing the line in 26:09:37.

In the men's race, Browning and Grygar were in stiff competition for first place all the way to Desolation Lake, leaving the aid station together at 5:30 p.m. By Scott Pass, Jeff had just pulled ahead of George and by the time they left Brighton, Jeff was 20 minutes ahead to cinch the lead.

Benjamin Lewis was in fifth at Francis Peak, and generally held that position until Mill Creek. Within the five miles to Desolation Lake, Benjamin had moved up to third, which he held to the finish.

By the Scotts Pass Aid station, the "die had been cast," with Jeff first, George second, and Benjamin third. It's interesting to note that this aid station was the point in the 2011 race where the position of the top three spots had also been set.

At the finish line ceremony, 14 runners were inducted into The Royal Order of The Crimson Cheetah, for which runners must finish the Wasatch Front 100 Mile Endurance Run in under 24 hours. Members of this order are inducted in a hallowed and bizarre ceremony that requires them to kneel before the officiator, listen to the official pronouncement, be tapped by the scepter, sing the official song (For He's A Jolly Good Runner), and receive their crown.

Also this year, one runner, David Toone, achieved his tenth finish and received the 10-





Year Ring at the award ceremony.

The "Spirit of the Wasatch" award is a beautifully crafted sculpture recognizing a person who has demonstrated the service and sportsman-hip that exemplifies the standards of Wasatch Front 100 Mile Endurance run. The 2012 Spirit of the Wasatch Award was presented to Ivan Thompson for his 16 years of service to the race. Ivan is the man the finishers get to visit for the wonderful massages he donates to the runners each year. Ivan's company is Advanced Therapeutic Massage, Inc. Every runner that has

stretched out on his table knows that Ivan exemplifies the ideal of excellence that Spirit of the Wasatch celebrates.

Another year of the Wasatch Front 100 Mile Endurance Run has been completed and we all return to more mundane labors. Although many runners stumble into the finish line thrilled that it's over and swear, "Never again," blisters do heal, muscles recover, and unpleasant memories fade. Soon we find that the joy of ultrarunning is on our mind again and we start
